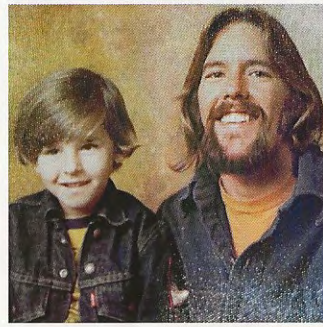

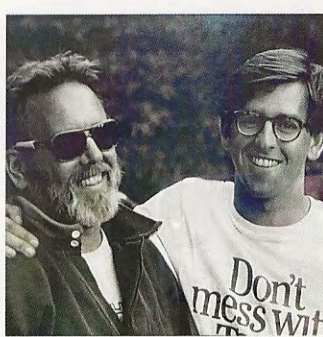

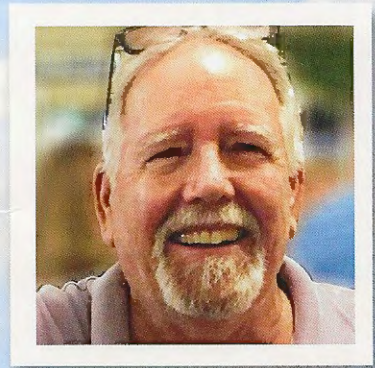

## Jeffrey H. Stark

Jeff Stark was born in Detroit, Michigan, on May 15, 1942. Jeff passed away on October 23, 2023, from Advanced Lewy Body Dementia at Hospice Maui. He was raised in New York and attended college at San Diego State University. In 1973, after an impromptu visit to Maui, he relocated from California to the

Valley Isle where he would spend the next fifty years of his life.

Jeff held numerous civic, public, and entrepreneurial roles that made him a prominent figure on Maui. Jeff established The Write Place, a commercial writing firm with offices in Honolulu and Maui. The Write Place worked with numerous companies to provide advertising and public relations in the pre-internet world. Some of the specialties of The Write Place were its résumé and job search functions that assisted people from all walks of life to search for and to find employment. This was something for which Jeff was particularly proud.

In the 1990s, Jeff was a pioneer in using the Internet to promote Hawaii tourism and initiatives to protect the environment. Jeff's "Our Environment" newspaper column and radio show were efforts to link people's everyday actions to addressing climate change, and to introduce new climate-friendly technologies such as electric vehicles and solar power to his audience. "Our Environment" was published by *The Maui News* and appeared on local radio stations.

Jeff was a board member of the Maui Economic Development Board (MEDB) for a number of years. He was a participant in the Maui Business and the Environment Conferences (BEACON) in the early 90s. He was part of the founders of the Maui Recycling Group, a non-profit that helped to launch recycling in the County of Maui; Zero Waste Maui; as well as the Citizens Climate Lobby, and other community-based organizations.

Jeff was an avid windsurfer, competitive golfer, and a recreational pilot who enjoyed Maui to its fullest. He is survived by his son, Jay Stark, daughter-in-law Rachel Donaldson, granddaughter Sofia Stark, grandson Sean Stark, and grandson Malcolm Huss, all of whom he loved and adored. A private service for family and friends will be held on December 30, 2023. In lieu of flowers, donations can be directed to The Maui Food Bank in his memory.
